What's On - Term 4 - 2017 Ocean View Children's Centre

Ocean View College and Children's Centre is a Birth to Year 12 Public School located in the suburb of Taperoo, 18.5 km from Adelaide's CBD.

The Children's Centre is open Monday to Friday from 7am to 6pm (355 days per year).

The Occupational Therapist (OT) and Speech Pathologist (SP) work with families and Children's Centre staff to support children's development in areas such as movement and hand skills, talking and understanding, behaviour and eating. The therapists are active in playgroups and by talking with families who come to the Centre.

The OT and SP program also supports parents in identifying children with delays in development, providing referral pathways to the NDIS, for example, and tailoring strategies and activity ideas to support children and families in the home.

The Family Services Coordinator (FSC) connects with local families with children aged 0-5 years. The FSC provides group and individual support for families around issues that affect parents, caregivers and their children, including the provision of information and links to other services.

The Community Development Coordinator (CDC) engages child, family, community and a range of services to understand, develop and represent local initiatives for creating a child friendly community. If you want to volunteer or contribute to our community with an education focus, please contact the CDC.

Getting here:

Train: On the Outer Harbour Line alight at Taperoo station (head north-west to Gedville Road)

Bus: Route 333 Port Adelaide to North Haven. Alight at stop 56.

The Children's Centre is situated nearest the roundabout (corner) of Military and Gedville Roads **at 23 Gedville Road, Taperoo.**

Anyone with children aged 0-5 years in the local area can access the programs or services listed on this timetable

You don't have to have children attending the Centre to be eligible to attend our community based programs listed on the timetable or to get in touch with our Speech Pathologist or Occupational Therapist.
